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## DEFINITIONS

### Acceptance, airplane

Receipt of legal title by the resident factory representative of the procuring agency.

### Accident, aircraft

An event involving one or more military aircraft that occurs while the aircraft is engaged in any phase of aerial flight and which results in death or major injury to persons or damage to aircraft which requires ten or more man-hours of labor to remove, repair and replace the damaged part or assembly.

### Aircraft

Any type of airplane or glider.

### Airframe weight

Empty weight of an airplane less the following government furnished equipment: engines, propellers, wheels, brakes, tires and tubes, auxiliary power plant, turbo-superchargers, radio receivers and transmitters, starters, batteries, generators, turrets and power-operated gun mounts.

### Airplane, combat

Any type of bomber, fighter or reconnaissance airplane.

### Airplane, first-line

One suited to perform the mission for which it was originally intended.

### Airplane, military

One produced for the use of the armed forces or a commercial airplane seating twelve or more passengers.

### Airplane, miscellaneous

One employed for such a non-tactical purpose as administrative or training flights.

### Airplane, second-line

One no longer considered operational due to such factors as age and obsolescence.

### Alaska

Alaska Air Command (Eleventh Air Force).

### China and India-Burma

India-Burma Theater, Tenth and Fourteenth Air Forces.

### Cognizance

Responsibility for negotiating for and inspecting the airplanes.

### Continental Air Forces

First, Second, Third and Fourth Air Forces and Troop Carrier Command.

### Delivery, airplane

Transfer of possession from the resident representative of the procuring agency to a representative of the Air Transport Command, a public carrier or other transporting agency.

### European Theater

European and Mediterranean Theaters.

### Graduates from Flying and Technical Training

Number of courses completed by students and not the number of different individuals graduated from AAF schools.

### Non-specialists

Basic soldiers, laborers, duty soldiers and unclassified personnel.

### Other Arms and Services

Armored Force, Adjutant General, Coast Artillery, Cavalry, Field Artillery, General Staff Inspector General, Infantry, Judge Advocate General, Military Intelligence, Transportation, and in the case of enlisted personnel, students in Army Service Forces schools.

### Other Continental US

AAF Center, Commanding General AAF, enroute to or at departure points and, beginning June 1945, enroute to or from overseas (previous to June 1945, in the overseas theater to or from which the personnel were enroute).

### Other Flying Training courses

Emergency Air Rescue Crew, Classification, Orientation and Processing courses and courses in War Training Service Schools and pools.

### Other Overseas

Caribbean Defense Command (Sixth Air Force, Antilles Air Command), Africa Middle East Theater, Bermuda, Iceland, Newfoundland, the Azores, Greenland, US Air Forces in South America, Army Airways Communications System, Commanding General Army Air Forces (Foreign), Air Transport Command (Foreign), unless shown separately.

### Other specialists

Primarily photographic, weather and mess personnel.

### Other Technical Training courses

Auto Mechanic, Clerk-Typist, Cook and Baker, Counter Intelligence, Link Trainer Mechanic, Mess Sergeant, Military Police (Aviation), Parachute Rigger and Repairman, Supply Clerk and Teletype Operator and Mechanic.

### Pacific Air Command, US Army

Far East Air Forces, Pacific Ocean Areas, US Army Strategic Air Forces (USASTAF).

### Personnel, field students

Enlisted personnel being trained on the job to fill any air force personnel requirement except the performance of permanent duties in Continental US.

### Personnel in bulk allotment

Personnel authorized to AAF activities in the form of a group of individuals rather than by Tables of Organization and Equipment.

### Personnel in committed units

Personnel in units manned and equipped under a Table of Organization and Equipment and scheduled to be shipped overseas at a known date.

### Personnel in permanent party

Personnel performing regular and recurring duties in Continental US.

### Personnel, non-operating

All personnel other than bulk allotment and permanent party.

## DEFINITIONS - Continued

Personnel, operating

Personnel in bulk allotment and in permanent party

Training, advanced

Training given to pilots subsequent to basic training and consisting of further military, ground and flying instruction, the latter in trainer aircraft more powerful than those previously used.

Training, basic

Training given to pilots subsequent to primary training and consisting of further military and ground instruction and a specified number of hours of instruction in trainer aircraft more powerful than those used in primary training.

Training, pre-flight

The initial training given to pilots, bombardiers and navigators to acquaint them with the fundamentals of flight.

Training, primary

Training given to pilots subsequent to pre-flight training and consisting of military instruction, academic instruction in ground school and a specified number of hours of instruction in a single-engine trainer airplane.

Training, transition

Training given to pilots subsequent to advanced training and designed to teach them to fly the particular model of airplane they are fly in combat.
